

## **CHIEF UMPIRE & RACE COMMITTEE CHAIR**

### **WHAT TO DO**

Chair the Race Committee if it is called upon to take action during the day.

### **WHERE TO DO IT**

You will be based in Bay 1 of the Avon County boathouse until racing begins. Please then proceed to the Finish during racing.

Both the long and short courses usually have Umpires performing the roles of Starter/Timer 1. You may receive information from Monitor 9 during racing, rather than the long course Starter. Radio relay is operated by Monitor 9.

There may be another Umpire in addition to you at the Finish.

### **HOW TO DO IT**

Monitors all have mobile phones and radios. They are instructed to report any incidents to the Chief Umpire as soon as possible after each division is completed. If you require more detail than that provided, please discuss with the relevant Monitor directly.

Advise Results Manager of the racing numbers of any boat involved in a dispute in the division just ended, and of your decision. *The Results Manager will expect a call at the end of each division, even if there are no problems.* Times for all crews (except those involved in disputes) will be published as soon as they are ready.
