

AVON SPRING HEAD

Parking and Coach Drop Off / Pick Up

Unfortunately, we don't have agreement to use the field where cars normally park for Avon Regatta.

PLEASE CAN CREWS AND SPECTATORS CAR SHARE AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE TO MINIMISE THE NUMBER OF VEHICLES COMING TO THE HEAD.

The parking plan for trailers, towing vehicles, minibuses and cars is below.

Trailers and towing vehicles and cars carrying boats

We believe that we can fit c.12 trailers around the Clubhouse and Boathouse. Please follow the parking marshal instructions when you arrive at our top field – some Clubs will be requested to tow their trailer under the railway bridge.

Cars/vans with boats on top may also be sent to park next to the Clubhouse and Boathouse.

The remaining trailers will be marshalled to park in the top field.

Please park trailers considerately, we have a lot of trailers and vehicles to fit in!

Minibuses

Minibuses will be marshalled to park in our top field.

Competitors and spectators

Please do your best to share cars; this event is always busy. There is unlikely to be parking for **any** visiting cars in the Saltford Rowing Centre outer field as the ground is very wet and space will be allocated to trailers and minibuses. Parking is widely available in the residential streets of Saltford, on the south side of the A4. It is then a 10-20 min walk to the site. See separate map on website for best places to park on the streets of Saltford.

There is also parking at Newbridge Park and Ride along the A4 towards Bath. If clubs can coordinate multiple cars to arrive at the same time and drop people off at the club, they could then drive to the Park and Ride and drivers then car share back to Saltford.

Blue badge holders

Turn into the trailer field and discuss with the parking marshal.

Coaches

Coaches must drop off and pick up on the Trailer Field side of the A4 (ie direction Bath) at least 20m from the Trailer Field entrance.

Coaches must not wait on the A4, but in Ashmead Road (near the roundabout at the eastern end of the Keynsham bypass) and be summoned when their passengers are ready to board.

Boat rigging

The owner of the field near the riverbank behind the Boathouse has agreed that we can use the space for boat rigging as there won't be much room next to the trailers for this.

The field can be accessed behind the Boathouse through a small parking area after you come under the railway bridge from the road. Please be careful of parked cars when carrying boats and trestles.
